Project 2012-13 Five-Year Review of NUC Standard

A 45-day comment period for the NUC-001-2 Five-Year Review recommendation and proposed Standard Authorization Request (SAR) is open through **8 p.m. Eastern on Monday, September 9, 2013**. The following documents have been posted:

1. Five-Year Review Draft Recommendation on NUC-001-2: Nuclear Plant Interface Coordination
2. Draft Standard Authorization Request Form to Propose Revisions to Nuclear Plant Interface Coordination (NUC-001-2)*

4. Unofficial Comment Form for Project # 2012-13 – Nuclear Plant Interface Coordination

The Standards Committee appointed seven subject matter experts to review the NUC standard as part of NERC's obligation to conduct periodic reviews of its standards. The NUC-001-2 Five-Year Review Team considered whether the standard should be reaffirmed, revised, or withdrawn, and has concluded that the standard requires revision to provide greater clarity and to sharpen industry focus on tasks that have a more direct impact on reliability.

*Please note that the SAR and redlined standard are posted to provide information on the scope of revisions proposed in the draft recommendation. Any changes to a standard will ultimately be made through the formal standards development process.

Stakeholders should review all posted documents – the Five-Year Review Team's recommendation, the draft SAR, and draft Proposed Revisions to NUC-001-2 – before offering feedback. If the Standards Committee accepts the recommendation, a formal standard development project will be prioritized and initiated as standards development resources are available.
