The Frequency Working Group Chair Raymond Vice made the following motion to the Resources Subcommittee (RS):

*The Resources Subcommittee requests that the NERC maintain no less than three (3) calendar years plus the current year of data on line and readily available for use by authorized users (a minimum of 3 years of data on January 1 and a maximum of 4 years of data on December 31 of the same year) for the EPG supported tools.*
