Review of High-Level Business Requirements

- Process of adding data, updating data, and retiring data is included in each part of the system.
- There are three types of users to manage the input of data: Reporting Parties, View Only, and System Administrator.
- Data access can be organized by source and type. Types would be confidential, metrics, etc.
- One issue is to identify which entity or entities will be Reporting Parties.
- The work of this Task Force could be reported more broadly to keep others informed and to promote coordinated efforts.

- The DRD system could be the system of record and help to verify forecasts and energy contributions from Demand Response.
- The data field to identify multiple reporting of the same data is intended to identify potential reporting conflicts, but needs more study to understand how to identify and follow up on issues.
- Regulation will need some additional work to identify its reporting format.
