About this Workshop:

The purpose of this workshop is to provide an overview of the efforts at NERC to collect performance data on demand response, introduce the Demand Response Availability Data System (DADS) to the industry, and provide detailed instruction on how to participate and submit data for the 2010 DADS Phase I program.

Workshop Scope:

This workshop is intended to provide interested entities the information needed to participate in the DADS Phase I project. Participants will be given instruction on how to complete the DADS Data Form and background on the definitions and terms used for DADS. Participants will be given the Phase I data form and instructions prior to the meeting to facilitate discussion during the workshop. The workshop is coordinated by NERC's Demand Response Data Task Force, who has developed the functional requirements of the system.

Workshop Format:

In this workshop, background will be provided on how the DADS system came to fruition and the driving forces behind the need to establish this common database. A majority of the workshop will be instructions on how to complete the supplied DADS Data Form. During this time, participants are encouraged to ask questions and bring any comments or suggestions to the group. This includes, in particular, questions or comments regarding terms and definitions used (e.g., "What does Advanced Notification mean?") or program/system-specific questions (e.g., "We have this program, but it doesn't quite fall into these categories."). Participants are encouraged to stop a presenter during the instruction portion of the workshop if a question arises.
