

1. Does SREC collect transmission data similar to TADS? **SREC has access to most of the TADS information but does not necessarily collect and categorize the information.**
2. Is the data being requested reasonable and obtainable? **It is not reasonable to expect SREC to provide the data because of its limited staff and because SREC has no material impact on the bulk electric system. The actual data being requested seems reasonable and most of it is obtainable for SREC.**
3. Are the metrics appropriate? **The metrics are of little use to SREC. Our metrics are much more streamlined. I do understand the metrics chosen facilitate universal data collection.**
4. Is the data reporting process reasonable? **I question having the RE involved if they are going to require information other than what is required for TADS. SREC's RE has proven to be inconsistent with NERC requirements. Other than that the process looks pretty straight forward.**
5. Is the implementation schedule reasonable? **Yes.**
6. Are there ambiguities in the manual? **I will know more about that when I have to complete the reporting.**
