NERC is posting the proposed SERC Reliability Corporation (SERC) Regional Reliability Standards Development Procedure for a 45-day industry review.

Regional standards development procedures define a regional entity's process for development, revision, reaffirmation, and withdrawal of regional reliability.

The NERC approval and posting requirements for regional reliability standards development procedures are described in [NERC's Rules of Procedure of the Electric Reliability Organization](#), Section 311.2.
