

**Implementation Plan for Standards Missing Measures and/or Compliance Information
When Approved as Version 0 Standards**

Prerequisite Approvals

There are no other reliability standards or Standard Authorization Requests (SARs), in progress or approved, that must be implemented before this set of standards can be implemented.

Modified Standards

Measures and/or compliance information were added to the following “Missing Measures” standards. There were no changes made to the requirements or to the list of entities responsible for complying with those requirements.

Compliance with Standards

Once these Missing Measures standards are effective, the responsible entities identified in each of the standards must comply with the requirements in that standard. Note that every standard in the set of Missing Measures standards is a modification of an already approved standard. Entities must continue to comply with all requirements in approved standards until the requirements in the approved standards are replaced or retired.

Proposed Effective Dates

The proposed changes to these standards will become effective on January 1, 2007. Entities are already expected to be fully compliant with all requirements in these standards so there is no extraordinary time delay between NERC Board of Trustees adoption and the effective date.

Balloting

There will be a single ballot for the entire set of standards listed above.
