BALLOT AND INFORMATIONAL WEBCAST FOR URGENT ACTION REVISION TO TLR PROCEDURE

Electronic balloting on the proposed [urgent action revision](#) to reliability standard IRO-006, Attachment 1 "Transmission Loading Relief Procedure - Eastern Interconnection" will occur from **May 23, 2005 (8 a.m. EDT) through June 3, 2005 (noon EDT)**. The revision addresses a dynamic schedule flowing on firm transmission that must be retagged per INT-004 because a change in the MW amount exceeds a threshold. Under the current TLR procedure, the Interchange Distribution Calculator would hold the new tag because it appears to be a new transaction, even though the dynamic schedule was already flowing. If approved, the proposed revision to Attachment 1 in INT-006-0 will correct this error and allow dynamic schedules to be updated without being held.

A public webcast will be held at 4 p.m. Monday May 23 to explain the proposed change. Those wishing to participate in the webcast are requested to dial in to 816-650-0756. The host is Gerry Cauley. All Registered Ballot Body (RBB) members wishing to vote on this revision are requested to enter the [ballot pool](#) prior to 8 a.m. EDT Monday May 23. The ballot pool will be closed once the ballot opens. To cast your electronic ballot, please access the [ballot page](#) and log on with your user ID and password. After logging on, members of the ballot pool will be able to cast a vote by clicking on the 'vote' link. (Note: you will not see the 'vote' link if you have not logged on or if you are not a member of this ballot pool). You may cast an 'affirmative' (approval), 'negative', or 'abstain' vote for the revision to the TLR procedure. Those casting either affirmative or negative votes will have the opportunity to also enter a comment on the ballot.

You may vote only once. Once you have reviewed your vote and are satisfied that it is as you intended, click the 'Submit' button. **Once you have submitted your ballot, your vote is final.** Ballot

results, including the vote of each entity in the ballot pool, will be publicly announced shortly after the ballot period closes. A two-thirds weighted industry segment vote in the affirmative is required to pass a NERC standard. Because NERC's standards development process is ANSI accredited, under certain circumstances a recirculation ballot may be required to approve this standard. The balloting procedure is described in the [Reliability Standards Process Manual](#).
