




# **Meeting Place**

The meeting place is at Place Dupuis: 845 Rue Sainte-Catherine E, Montréal, QC, H2L 4P5








It's a 1,1 Km walk on Ste-Catherine St. or you can take the subway from Place des arts Station to Berri-Uqam Station.

## Taxi (<a href="http://www.admtl.com/en/access/taxis-limousines">http://www.admtl.com/en/access/taxis-limousines</a>)

You can get a taxi at the arrivals level near the central exit, where a dispatcher will assist you. No reservation is required. All taxi operators working out of Montréal—Trudeau are required to have a permit and to comply with its terms and conditions. Occasionally, during periods of excessive demand, Aéroports de Montréal may call on outside operators.

**Taxi fares:** Fares by meter for all other destinations except downtown. Minimum rate of \$17 (Cad).

#### Montréal-Trudeau / Downtown

Fixed fare	\$40 (Cad)
Minimum fare	\$17 (Cad)
Other destination	meter

**Payment methods:** Visa, MasterCard and American Express credit cards are accepted. Some drivers accept U.S. currency but provincial regulations require customers to pay in Canadian currency.



#### Shuttle service

The 747 shuttle service runs **24 hours a day, 7 days a week**, between Montréal-Trudeau airport and Berri-UQAM métro station. Travel times range from 45 to 70 minutes, depending on traffic conditions. Your bus stop will be at the corners of Jeanne-Mance and René-Lévesque if you're going to the Hyatt Regency or the Hilton Garden Inn. For the Delta Hotel your bus stop is on the corners of Union and René-Lévesque and for the Hotel Gouverneur the bus stop will be on Berri and Ste-Catherine St.

The cost of a ticket is \$10 (Cad). In turn, it offers you unlimited transit use on STM's bus and métro networks for **24 consecutive hours. The following fares are also accepted on the 747 at no additional cost:** Monthly or weekly regular or reduced passes, 4-month pass, Unlimited Weekend, 1- and 3-day passes, and monthly TRAM passes zones 1 to 8. Several options to purchase transit fares

#### At the P.-E.-Trudeau airport:

There are four fare vending machines in the international arrivals area. Payment in cash, by debit card or with VISA or MasterCard credit cards are accepted.

#### In the bus:

The \$10 fare can also be paid in cash with exact change on the bus. (Only coins are accepted (no bank bills)).


