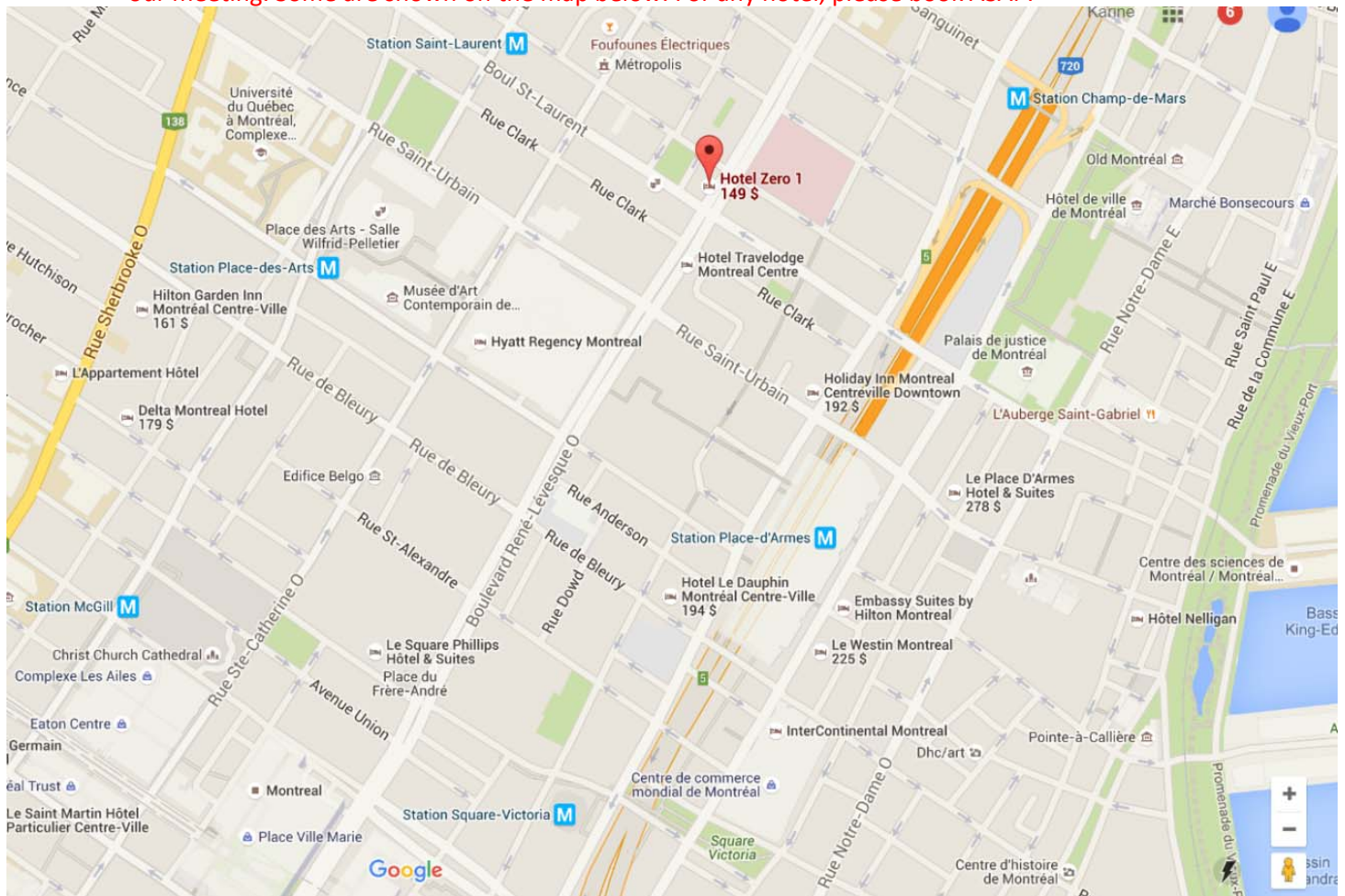

Transportation from Montreal-Trudeau Airport

Taxi : 40 \$ Flat rate to downtown, same back to the airport.

747 shuttle bus (24h/24, frequent departures during the day):

Fare-card can be purchased at machines inside terminal, after exiting the secured area.

If you plan on using the shuttle back to the airport or bus/subway during the week, it could be worthwhile to purchase a 3-day or weekly subway/bus pass that would be valid for the shuttle.

When planning your trip back to the airport, please be aware that traffic can be awful during rush hour, and that check-in (luggage and boarding pass) must be completed 60 minutes prior to departure of any flight to the US, with any airline. Also, on the way out, you need to go through US customs in Montreal airport in addition to security.
