Re: NERC FFT Informational Filing – Errata
FERC Docket No. RC13-10-000

On June 27, 2013, the North American Electric Reliability Corporation (NERC) submitted a Find, Fix, Track and Report (FFT) informational filing. It has come to NERC's attention that (1) the acronym associated with two of the remediated issues was inadvertently incorrect and (2) the violation ID number associated with two numbers were incorrect. Specifically, the Orlando Utilities Commission acronym listed in the 'Description of Remediated Issue' column for the violations FRCC2012009679 and FRCC2012009954 should be "OUC" not "NSB." Also, the violation ID number associated with Southwest Power Pool Regional Entity American Electric Power Service Corp. As Agent For Public Svc. Co. Of Oklahoma & SW Ele Pwr Co. should be SPP2012011325 instead of SPP20121011325 and the violation ID number associated with ReliabilityFirst Corporation Registered Entity 3 should be RFC2013012427 instead of RFC2012012427. NERC's instant filing includes, in Attachment A, a revised FFT Spreadsheet reflecting the correction.

Request for Confidential Treatment

Attachment A includes confidential information as defined by the Commission's regulations at 18 C.F.R. Part 388 and orders, as well as NERC Rules of Procedure including the NERC CMEP Appendix 4C to the Rules of Procedure. This includes non-public information related to certain Reliability Standards possible violations and confidential information regarding critical energy infrastructure.

In accordance with the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, 18 C.F.R. § 388.112, a non-public version of the information redacted from the public filing is being provided under separate cover.
