The North American Electric Reliability Corporation ("NERC") respectfully submits this supplemental information to the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("FERC" or the "Commission") regarding the Western Electricity Coordinating Council Reliability Coordinator violations that were included in the September 13, 2010 Omnibus II filing under the name of NERC as Compliance Enforcement Authority ("CEA") in the above referenced proceeding. <sup>1</sup>

Specifically, the instant filing provides additional information regarding the risk to the bulk power system during the pendency of the violation up to and including mitigation of the violation. The new additional text is denoted by red font.
