

**NEW BRUNSWICK ENERGY AND UTILITIES BOARD**

**IN THE MATTER** of an Application by New Brunswick Power Corporation pursuant to the *Electricity Act SNB 2013 c.7* and with respect to Reliability Standard BAL-003

**ORDER**

**WHEREAS** the New Brunswick Energy and Utilities Board (Board) has received an Application from the New Brunswick Power Corporation (the “Corporation”) pursuant to *Electricity Act* and the *Reliability Standards Regulation* seeking an Order as follows:

- (1) approving modifications of Board approved reliability standard BAL-003-0.1b and NB Appendix BAL-003-0.1b-NB-0 by approving new version BAL-003-1 and NB Appendix BAL-003-1-NB-0, and
- (2) approving retirement of existing Board approved reliability standard BAL-003-0.1b and NB Appendix BAL-003-0.1b-NB-0; and
- (3) orders and/or directions with respect to such other matters as the Board sees fit.

**AND WHEREAS** pursuant to section 8 of the *Reliability Standards Regulation* the Board is required to notify all registered entities, the North American Electric Reliability Corporation (NERC) as the standards body and the Northeast Power Coordinating Council (NPCC) as the compliance body of this Application;

**AND WHEREAS** pursuant to section 8 of the *Reliability Standards Regulation*, the Board is required to post the Application on its website;

**NOW THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. A copy of the Application shall be posted on the Board's website at [www.nbeub.ca](http://www.nbeub.ca) commencing no later than Tuesday May 27, 2014 in both English and French;
2. Notices, in English and in French, in the form attached hereto and marked "A" are to be provided by Board staff to all registered entities, NERC and NPCC on or before Tuesday May 27, 2014;
3. English and French notices in the form attached hereto and marked "A" are to be posted on the Board's website at [www.nbeub.ca](http://www.nbeub.ca) commencing no later than Tuesday May 27, 2014 and shall remain posted until at least Monday, July 28<sup>th</sup>, 2014;
4. Registered entities, NERC and NPCC are invited to submit written comment to the Board regarding the Application on or before Monday, July 28, 2014 at [general@nbeub.ca](mailto:general@nbeub.ca) or by mail at the address below. Please refer to Matter 250 in your correspondence.
