NOTICE OF EXTENSION OF TIME

(February 15, 2012)

On November 22, 2011, the North American Electric Reliability Corporation (NERC) filed a motion for a two-year extension of time, until September 30, 2014, to address the directive in the Commission's Order No.742<sup>1</sup> to consider whether personnel that support EMS applications should be included in mandatory training as described in Project 2010-01 – Support Personnel Training (Project), by August 23, 2012. NERC states that based on its 2012-2014 prioritization effort and associated work plan development, the proposed Project was postponed and is expected to be initiated in the fourth quarter of 2012, pending further research to properly define the scope of the Project.

Upon consideration, notice is hereby given that NERC is granted a two-year extension of time to and including September 30, 2014 to complete the Project pursuant to the Commission's Order No. 742.
