NOTICE EXTENDING COMMENT PERIOD

(December 16, 2010)

On December 6, 2010, Edison Electric Institute (EEI) filed a motion requesting an extension of the period in which to file comments in response to the Commission's Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (Proposed Rule), issued November 18, 2010, in the above-referenced proceeding.¹ EEI requests a 30-day extension of the comment period, which would result in a comment due date of March 2, 2011. By notice issued December 8, 2010, the Commission required answers to EEI's motion to be filed on or before December 13, 2010. Bonneville Power Administration, Los Angeles Department of Water and Power, and NorthWestern Corporation filed answers or responsive comments supporting EEI's request for a 30-day extension of the comment period.

Upon consideration, notice is hereby given that the period during which interested parties may file comments in response to the Commission's Proposed Rule in this proceeding is extended by 30 days. Comments are now due on or before March 2, 2011.
