**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF COMPLIANCE FILING DEADLINE OF THE NORTH  
AMERICAN ELECTRIC RELIABILITY CORPORATION AND NORTHEAST POWER  
COORDINATING COUNCIL, INC. IN RESPONSE TO ORDER CONDITIONALLY  
APPROVING AMENDMENTS TO THE BYLAWS OF NORTHEAST POWER  
COORDINATING COUNCIL, INC.**

Pursuant to Rules 212 and 2008 of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission’s (“Commission”) Rules of Practice and Procedure,<sup>1</sup> the North American Electric Reliability Corporation (“NERC”) and Northeast Power Coordinating Council, Inc. (“NPCC”) respectfully request Commission approval of a 30-day extension of the deadline to submit the compliance filing required by the Commission’s July 8 order in the above-caption proceeding conditionally approving amendments to the NPCC Bylaws (the “Bylaws”).<sup>2</sup> Extending the deadline would provide NERC and NPCC sufficient time to obtain the necessary approvals from the NPCC Board of Directors, NPCC members, and the NERC Board of Trustees.

On March 11, 2022, NERC and NPCC submitted a joint petition, pursuant to section 215(e)(4) of the Federal Power Act (“FPA”) and section 39.10 (2021) of the Commission’s regulations, requesting that the Commission approve revisions to the NPCC bylaws. In its July 8 order, the Commission accepted certain proposed revisions and directed petitioners to submit a compliance filing related to two of the proposed bylaw revisions within 60 days of the date of the order (i.e., September 6, 2022).

NPCC has already begun the process of revising its bylaws in accordance with the Commission’s Order. Nevertheless, to ensure NPCC has sufficient time to complete all of the procedural steps necessary to revise its bylaws, NERC and NPCC are seeking an additional 30 days to submit the compliance filing. To revise its bylaws, NPCC’s procedures require approvals from its Corporate Governance and Nominating Committee (“CGNC”), Board of Directors, and its membership prior to sending to the NERC Board of Trustees and the Commission for approval. An additional 30 days would help accommodate the time needed to obtain these necessary approvals prior to submitting for FERC approval.

For the foregoing reasons, NERC and NPCC respectfully request that the Commission approve the requested 30-day extension to submit the compliance filing.
