

## Notice of Proposed Revisions to NERC Rules of Procedure and Request for Comments

45-Day Comment Period: 04-13-2015 through 05-28-2015

### Proposed Revisions to Rules of Procedure

The North American Electric Reliability Corporation (NERC) is proposing changes to its Rules of Procedure Section 302.1 and Appendices 5A & 5B, in accordance with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's March 19, 2015 *Order on Electric Reliability Organization Risk Based Registration Initiative and Requiring Compliance Filing*, 150 FERC ¶ 61,213.

NERC requests comments on the proposed revisions to the NERC Rules of Procedure. The 45-day comment period begins Monday, April 13, 2015 and ends Thursday, May 28, 2015.

### Process

NERC's bylaws specify the procedure to be followed in making changes to NERC's Rules of Procedure. Such changes must be publicly posted for a 45-day comment period before being considered by the NERC Board of Trustees. (Bylaws, Article XI, Section 2.) Such changes must also be approved by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission before they may take effect in the U.S. No equivalent approval is required from any ERO governmental authority in Canada. The changes, if approved, will take effect on the same date throughout the jurisdictions in which NERC operates.
