Mr. Conway has focused his efforts on supporting and providing the opinions of how end users of all sizes, and small utilities are affected by the decisions and policies at NERC.</b></p> <p><b>Mr. Conway has most recently been working with Large End Industrial Users who are interfaced with several Regional Entities. These utilities own their interface facilities which are affected by the guidance, definition and interpretations of NERC. Some of these users also own and/or operate generation, transmission and distribution facilities within their industrial complexes to support various processes. In some cases, providing wholesale power sales to the interconnection. As the Regions continue to identify all users, owners and operators of the BES these facilities are being evaluated more like utilities than Large End Users of large facilities with internal electrical systems. Mr. Conway has continued to provide guidance and representation at the NERC level to best help NERC and the Regions understand these commercial users and their unique situations and develop well informed policies.</b></p>
