Q5 Briefly describe the nominee's experience and qualifications to serve on the RSTC:

Roman has 36 years of electric utility experience and for the most recent seven years has served as Director of Practices, Peer Reviews, Assistance, Training and Knowledge Management at the North American Transmission Forum (NATF). As a director, Roman provides leadership for the development of reliability best practices, workshops, principles of operating excellence, peer review assessments, reliability assistance, focused training and the development of key metric performance indicators to promote excellence in the operation of our members' electric transmission system (membership comprises 80 percent of 200 kV and above line miles in North America).

He also has 25 years of industry experience with the Southern Company, holding various positions of engineering and managerial roles in power delivery (overhead and underground design), generation (unit commitment for the dispatch of 38 GWs of generation, scheduling of maintenance and planned outages, and for FERC policy) and transmission (leadership and oversight for reliability compliance and maintaining audit readiness for the Balancing Authority, Reliability Coordinator, Transmission Operator, Transmission Service Provider functions. He also served as coordinator for ballot body voting.

Roman was employed four years with the North American Electric Reliability Corporation (NERC) serving in leadership roles in compliance, events analysis (managed the Events Analysis Subcommittee) and as manager of situation awareness and reliability assurance. He was credited and responsible for standing up and implementing NERC's situational awareness program known as SAFNR (the real-time monitoring of the bulk power system) and published numerous NERC Alerts.

Roman holds a bachelor's degree in mechanical engineering from Auburn University and a master's degree in mechanical engineering from the University of Alabama.
