Q5 Briefly describe the nominee's experience and qualifications to serve on the RSTC:

Mr. Guttormson is the Manager Interconnections, System Planning and Asset Management at SaskPower. His department is accountable for recommending system development plans to meet NERC reliability standards (e.g., PC, TP, TO, etc.) and provide for the safe and reliable operation of the SaskPower system; as well as planning for generation interconnections, open access transmission tariff service, and inter-ties to the SaskPower system. He is a member of SaskPower's planning and operating coordination committees with the Southwest Power Pool, Manitoba, and Alberta. Mr. Guttormson has worked for SaskPower for over 25 years in power systems planning. He has a M.Sc. in electrical engineering, and is a Professional engineer in the province of Saskatchewan.

He has been an active participant at the NERC and regional level. He has been a member of the NERC Planning Committee since 2016, is currently part of the NERC PC executive committee, and was a member of the NERC Methods for Establishing Interconnection Reliability Operating Limits task force. He is past chair of the MRO Standards Committee, has served on the MRO Planning Committee, and still participates on the MRO's working group to review remedial action schemes in the MRO region.

At the Canadian level, he is the current chair of the Canadian Electricity Association's Electric Regulatory Advisory committee. The committee's primary focus is on national and North American regulatory issues affecting multiple provinces or related to international transmission. He also participates in Natural Resources Canada's Utility Forum, which focuses on the planning and operation of power systems with high penetration of non-synchronous generation technologies, the Canadian technical review committee for the North American Renewable Integration Study, and the Centre for Energy Advancement through Technological Innovation (CEATI) power system planning and operations program.
