Summary

In an effort to increase awareness and ensure bulk power system reliability, in March 2023, the ERO Enterprise conducted Cold Weather Small Group Advisory Sessions to discuss cold weather preparedness Standards and possible compliance approaches in an open, non-audit environment. During the course of those discussions, the ERO Enterprise provided guidance on specific approaches for implementing Reliability Standards EOP-011-2, IRO-010-4, and TOP-003-5. In addition, the ERO Enterprise conducted a general session Live Webinar¹ to discuss the cold weather preparedness Standards and possible compliance concerns.

NERC staff will update the Board of Trustees Compliance Committee on the engagements, including lessons learned.
