NERC Board Begins Search for New Member

ATLANTA – The North American Electric Reliability Corporation’s Board of Trustees seeks a new member to help lead this unique, dynamic international organization dedicated to grid reliability and security.

NERC’s Board is comprised of 10 independent members plus the president and chief executive officer of NERC. Prospective candidates will be interviewed by members of the Board’s Nominating Committee, which includes representation from the Member Representatives Committee (MRC). Recommendations will then be presented to the full MRC for vote at the annual meeting in February 2018.

NERC is a not-for-profit international regulatory authority whose mission is to assure the reliability and security of the bulk power system in North America. NERC’s areas of responsibility spans the continental United States, Canada, and the northern portion of Baja California, Mexico. NERC is the Electric Reliability Organization for North America, subject to oversight by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission and governmental authorities in Canada and Mexico.
