Our revamped search engine will deliver more relevant results much faster. By improving metadata tagging standardizing naming conventions, and adhering to a website retention policy, we're making it much easier to quickly locate the documents you need and ensuring the system does not get bogged down with out-of-date information.

Stakeholder Involvement and Next Steps

What role have stakeholders played in this project?

Stakeholder input has been critical in shaping the new website. Throughout the project, NERC has engaged with stakeholders to ensure the platform meets the needs of industry. We prioritized project deliverables based on information gathered from one-on-one interviews and a public survey. Additionally, NERC will conduct a stakeholder pilot prior in the coming months, allowing select stakeholders to explore the new site and provide feedback to further refine the platform before launch or during additional project phases.

Will there be training or guidance on how to use the new site?

Absolutely—we will provide training materials, guides, and video tutorials to help users get familiar with the new layout and maximize the new website features as we get closer to our launch date.

Will the website continue to evolve after launch?

This launch is just the first phase focused on **improving the user experience**. We are implementing the modernization in three phases. This initial phase focuses on introducing core improvements to the user experience (e.g., modern design, improved search and navigation, multimedia enhancements). The two subsequent phases will incorporate user feedback and introduce more interactive features and enhanced user personalization to make NERC.com an even more powerful resource.
