

# System Restoration and Blackstart SAR DT Conference Call

December 11, 2006

#### 1. Administrative Items

**a.** Introductions and Quorum

### **b.** NERC Antitrust Compliance Guidelines

The NERC Antitrust Compliance Guidelines were provided to all members via e-mail and were reviewed at this time.

#### **c.** Accept volunteers for vice chair position

Members were asked to see if they knew of anyone in the WECC who might be able to join the team so that we had a west coast point of view represented.

## 2. Drafting Team Actions

#### a. Review SDT material

It was emphasized that the packet of material sent out to the drafting team was just a review guide and that there was more to do than what was included in this material. The main element of this packet was the standards review sheets that contained a summary of comments that have been accumulated over the years from different sources such as the FERC NOPR or industry comments. This is not the exhaustive list of what the drafting team is to address. Basically, the team needs to write the SAR such that the subsequent standards drafting team has the power and flexibility to do whatever is needed to get this done right. This could include eliminating some of the existing standards, merging existing work, etc.

### **b.** SAR comment review

This is the SAR drafting team, not the standards drafting team. While some of the members of the SAR DT may carry over to the standards drafting team, it is not a requirement.

Dick has made a preliminary review of the SAR comments and has placed them in 5 general categories:

- o Tighten up the SAR so it is not just a laundry list
- o RRO vs. RC involvement vs. applicable entities
- o Identify specific entities and why they are included
- Resolve conflicts and redundancies
- o Specific recommendations

NERC will provide a comment response form by the end of the week. All members were encouraged to review the Standards Development Process documents that are available on the NERC web site.
