1. Next Steps for FAC-011

V. Howell provided a summary of the meeting the SDT had with FERC on May 2, 2019. Feedback was provided asking the SDT to collect data for SOL exceedances for analysis regarding the concept of T_r . The SDT will meet to determine the parameters of the data collection and identify what entities to request data from.

2. FAC-015 Proposed Revisions

H. Singh and T. Leslie presented the concepts for the FAC-015 proposed revisions to the team. The revisions consisted of proposed drafts for Requirements staying in FAC-015, moving to other FAC standards, and being placed in TPL-001. The sub-group combined Requirements R1 through R3 into one Requirement and made revisions to Requirement R4 based on industry comments. A concern was brought up about requiring entities to use the System voltage limits that the Reliability Coordinators are using. A question asked about entities having unlimited exceptions for meeting the criteria in FAC-015 based on the revisions of the Requirements and their respective locations. H. Singh responded by saying that was not the intention of the SDT.
