

Implementation Plan for COM-002-3 — Communication and Coordination

Defined Terms in the NERC Glossary

The RC SDT proposes the following new definition:

Reliability Directive: A communication initiated by a Reliability Coordinator, Transmission Operator or Balancing Authority where action by the recipient is necessary to address an Emergency or Adverse Reliability Impact.

Prerequisite Approvals

Conforming Changes to Requirements in Already Approved Standards

Effective Dates

COM-002-3 shall become effective the first day of the first calendar quarter following applicable regulatory approval – or in those jurisdictions where no regulatory approval is required, the first day of the first calendar quarter following Board of Trustees adoption.

Retirements

COM-002-2 shall be retired at midnight on the day that COM-002-3 becomes effective.

Revision Summary

The RC SDT contends that COM-002-2, R1 and its subrequirements are low level facilitating requirements that are more appropriately and inherently monitored under various higher-level performance-based reliability requirements for each entity throughout the body of standards.
