Therefore, doing one webinar for all the standards after making changes after each outreach would be a better strategic plan to deliver a finished product ready for ballot.
- 4. Discuss Plan of Action for MOD-032 revisions**
- a. MOD-32 revisions are on hold, given the upcoming project of Milestone 3 FERC Order 901 (to be filed by Nov 2025) to be discussed and posted for comments at the May Standards Committee meeting. It may be possible that Milestone 3 and the 2022-04 SDT can collaborate on revisions as needed for MOD-032, but a reminder that EMT is excluded from the FERC Order 901.
- 5. Discuss in person meeting options**
- a. Pending schedule kick off meeting for MOD-032 revisions for 2nd or 3rd week of June noting that joint PMOS/SC meeting is 2nd week of June. Plans to have a 1.5 day meeting scheduled for 15 to 20 people in person. Host meeting places to be discussed offline with chairs and NERC staff.
