- **3. Background of project** Charlie Cook shared a presentation outlining the San Fernando Disturbance report, key findings, and recommendations. In addition, he outlined the purpose and key deliverables of the Standards Authorization Request (SAR).
- **4.** Administrative Outlined important administrative items for the SDT members.

- **5. Overview of Standards Drafting Team Process** Utilized the SPM to walk through each phase of the standard development process with a focus on the SAR revisions and consideration of comment. Clarified the difference between informal and formal comment periods. Discussed next steps required to transition into the standards development phase.
- 6. Review Consideration of Comments The SAR DT reviewed and discussed multiple industry comments and whether the SAR should be revised based on the comment. Overall there is general industry support for the SAR with some commenters requesting slight revisions. The members discussed if the SAR should be revised to distinguish between BES and BPS connect facilities, and resolved that the SAR should not delineate between the two. The team felt it was more about whether or not the Balancing Authority had visibility to the facilities in question. The SAR DT voted unanimously to approve the revisions to the SAR as discussed, and submit the SAR to the SC at its May 17 meeting.
