Texas RE has requested NERC to post the proposed retirement of Regional Reliability Standard IRO-006-TRE-1 - IROL and SOL Mitigation in the ERCOT Region for industry review and comment as provided by the NERC Rules of Procedure.

Regional Reliability Standards Development Process

Section 300 of <u>NERC's Rules of Procedures of the Electric Reliability Organization</u> governs the regional reliability standards development process. Although the technical aspects of this Regional Reliability Standard have been vetted through Texas RE's Regional Standards development process, the final approval process for a Regional Reliability Standard requires NERC publicly to notice and request comment on the criteria outlined in the unofficial comment forms.
