#### **Cold Weather Preparedness Small Group Advisory Sessions Announced**

The week of May 6, NERC will host virtual small group advisory sessions (SGAS) with registered entities and the Regional Entities to assess the implementation of the Extreme Cold Weather Preparedness Standard, EOP-012-2, which was filed with FERC on February 16, 2024. The event will consist of two parts:

 General Session Live Webinar: A general interest session will be held to discuss EOP-012-2. Registration for a one-on-one session is not necessary to participate in this general session.

• SGAS One-on-One Sessions: Closed, one-on-one discussions between a registered entity's subject matter experts and ERO Enterprise staff about issues pertinent to that entity's implementation of EOP-012-2 and any other cold weather-related concerns. Registered entities will be asked to provide specific questions and discussion topics prior to the scheduled one-on-one session. NERC will schedule the one-on-one sessions after registration is received and is coordinated with Regional Entity staff. Registration for these one-on-one sessions must be received by NERC by Friday, March 22, 2024.

#### Registration

• **SGAS One-on-One Sessions:** NERC will accept SGAS one-on-one registrations on a first-come, first-serve basis; so, if the number of requests exceeds the time allotted, NERC will coordinate alternative arrangements.

- There is no limit to the number of SMEs who can participate in SGAS sessions.
- NERC will notify those who request a SGAS of their appointment time so the registered entity can make staff arrangements accordingly.

#### **OTHER NEWS**

#### **NEW Credential Maintenance Program Provider Fee to Increase in 2025 and 2026**

Due to future program changes that will require enhancements to SOCCED, the Personnel Certification Governance Committee (PCGC) voted to increase Provider program fees using a phased-in approach beginning January 1, 2025, and January 1, 2026.

The PCGC reviewed the services and products provided by the system operator certification, renewal, and provider areas, as it related to the income generated and the expenses occurred through the program. The PCGC concluded to not adjust the System Operator fees for exams and renewals at this time, and to further align services provided to the cost for those services, the PCGC will raise fees only on the Program Providers.

The increase to each provider's renewal fee is based on the level, as it is related to the cost impact of the service; thus, a

different percentage of increase for each of the program's provider offerings. This weighted process was chosen to more accurately reflect the costs that are directly associated with the offerings and support of provider-related products.
