#### **NEW Align Release Notes Posted**

Align Release 7.4.0 successfully deployed on September 6, 2025. This deployment included modifications to correct existing functionality or to improve user experience in the following modules: Enforcement Processing, Mitigation Management, Periodic Data Submittal, Self-Certification, Audits and Spot Checks, IRAs, and Standards. The modifications include, but limited to: corrections to the SEL path for Audit Findings and IRAs; fix to the export of Applicability Reliability Standards; new Self-Logging data fields; registered entity ability to include cause codes on the Finding form; corrections to cause code language; new emails for when Mitigation is submitted to CEA for review and when Milestone Extension Request is submitted to CEA; updates to the

### **NEW Updated Align User Guides**

The Align User Guides for Enforcement and Mitigation modules have been updated to reflect the improved functionality deployed with Align Release 7.4.0. #### **NEW Compliance Guidance Update**

#### **NEW Currently Compliant Podcast – Episode 7 Released**

NERC is pleased to announce the release of the seventh installment of its compliance podcast, "Currently Compliant." The podcast is intended to be a quick way to bring attention to frequently asked questions and provide clear insights on important compliance topics. Currently Compliant: Episode 7 focuses on the topic of Abeyance. The episode defines the concept of abeyance and clarifies how it will be used within the ERO Enterprise. The discussion addresses common questions, including the crucial role of "good faith" implementation, how abeyance periods are determined, and what entities should do if they are not audited during an abeyance period. The conversation also covers how feedback will be gathered and communicated to industry. This episode is hosted by Ryan Mauldin, Senior Engineer at NERC, and features Lonnie Ratliff, NERC's Director of Compliance Assurance. They are joined by a special guest, Erin Cullum Marcussen, Senior Manager of Compliance at Southwest Power Pool, who provides a valuable stakeholder perspective on this new process.
