NEW Posted: Reliability Standard Audit Worksheet

A new [RSAW](#) has been posted to the RSAW homepage under the heading ‘Current RSAWs for Use’ for TPL-008-1. It is a new NERC Reliability Standard pertaining to system planning for extreme weather. It requires (1) the development of benchmark planning cases based on major prior extreme heat and cold weather events and/or meteorological projections, (2) planning for extreme heat and cold weather events using steady state and transient stability analysis expanded to cover a range of extreme weather scenarios, including the expected availability of the resource mix during extreme heat and cold weather conditions and wide-area impacts of extreme heat and cold weather, and (3) development of corrective action plans that mitigate any instances where performance requirements for extreme heat and cold weather events are not met. TPL-008-1 has an effective date of April 1, 2026.

MODERNIZATION OF STANDARDS PROCESSES AND PROCEDURES TASK FORCE (MSPPTF) NEWS

NEW Posted: MSPPTF White Paper Stakeholder Comments

The Modernization of Standards Processes and Procedures Task Force (MSPPTF) has posted stakeholder feedback on the July 2025 white paper, [Potential Options for Transforming the Reliability Standards Development Framework](#). Nearly 100 submissions were received during the white paper comment period and the MSPPTF appreciates the thoughtful and constructive input received. The task force is now focused on reviewing the comments as it begins to prepare its draft recommendations which will be posted for public comment in late October. Stakeholder input will also be solicited during in-person forums and webinars. In addition, task force members will continue to present to NERC Standing Committees, engage directly with their trade organizations, and hold other informal discussions. The MSPPTF will present its final recommendations to the NERC Board of Trustees in February 2026. More specifics on these engagements will be shared through the [MSPPTF webpage](#).

NEW Level 2 NERC Alert Posted

NERC issued a [Level 2 Alert Recommendation](#) to Industry, *Large Load Interconnection, Study, Commissioning, and Operations*, to Distribution Providers (DP), Transmission Owners (TO), Transmission Planners (TP), Planning Coordinators (PC), Reliability Coordinators (RC), Resource Planners (RP), Transmission Operators (TOP), and Balancing Authorities (BA). The alert includes five primary recommendations regarding TO interconnection requirements, TP and PC interconnection and system-wide studies, TO load commissioning, TO operating protocols, and long-term forecasting for TPs, RPs, and PCs. NERC registered entities should note that only entities registered as the above-mentioned functional groups will be able to view and respond to the alert in the NERC Alert System. However, the alert is public and may be viewed at the link above. The alert has a response due date of January 28, 2026

On September 10, FERC issued an [Order](#) directing NERC to submit a report in an informational filing, on best practices to reduce the risk of wildfire ignition from the Bulk-Power System. The filing is due by May 1, 2026.

NEW Sunshine Act Agenda Posted for Upcoming FERC Open Meeting

FERC released the Sunshine Act open agenda for its upcoming [September 18, 2025 meeting](#). There are four items of interest to NERC relating to its responsibilities under Section 215 of the FPA:

- **E - 1 - RM25-8-000 - Critical Infrastructure Protection Reliability Standard CIP-003-11 – Cyber Security – Security Management Controls**

This item relates to NERC's petition for approval of proposed Reliability Standard CIP-003-11.

- **E - 2 - RM24-8-000 - Virtualization Reliability Standards**

This item relates to NERC's petition for approval of eleven Critical Infrastructure Protection Reliability Standards addressing virtualization and other matters identified during implementation of prior CIP Reliability Standards versions.

- **E - 3 - RD25-7-000 - North American Electric Reliability Corporation**

This item relates to NERC's petition for approval of proposed Reliability Standard EOP-012-3.

- **E - 4 - RM24-4-000 Supply Chain Risk Management Reliability Standards Revisions; RM20-19-000 - Equipment and Services Produced or Provided by Certain Entities Identified as Risks to National Security**

This item relates to two dockets regarding supply chain issues. First, a Notice of Inquiry (NOI) issued Sept. 17, 2020 (RM20-19-000). NERC and the Regional Entities submitted [comments on Nov. 23, 2020](#). Second, FERC issued a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (NOPR) on Sept. 19, 2024 (RM24-4-000) regarding Supply Chain standards. NERC and the Regional Entities submitted [comments on Nov. 22, 2024](#).
