Briefly describe the nominee's experience and qualifications to serve on the RSTC:

Brett Kruse is Calpine Corporation's Vice President of Market Design and Vice President, Governmental and Regulatory Affairs East/Midwest. In this role, he is or has been responsible for Calpine's interests in ISO-NE/NEPOOL, MISO, SPP, NYISO, and PJM. He also worked on nodal market development and implementation in ERCOT and the California ISO. He is also responsible for certain aspects of asset and portfolio optimization including trading and optimization strategies, transmission solutions, and Balancing Area interaction for the Eastern Interconnection. He served on the Southeastern Electric Reliability Corporation (SERC) Board of Directors for 15 years and served on the SPP Board/Members Committee for 5 years, and currently is on the Boards of the New England Power Generators Association (NEPGA) and the Coalition of Midwest Power Producers (COMPP). Brett has almost 40 years of experience in power systems operations and management, power plant operations and management, asset management, transmission, wholesale electricity market design, and regulatory affairs. Prior to joining Calpine in 2001, he held a variety of positions of increasing responsibility at Progress Energy, Reliant Energy, the Institute of Nuclear Power Operations (INPO), Houston Lighting and Power, and has worked as a consultant. Brett studied at Texas A&M University and the State University of New York, Albany, and has held a number of professional certifications.
