Robert (Bob) G. Clark was elected to the NERC Board of Trustees in February 2013. Mr. Clark serves on the Corporate Governance and Human Resources, Enterprise-wide Risk, Finance and Audit, and Nominating Committees. Mr. Clark previously served as vice chair of the Board.

From 2000 to 2009, Mr. Clark served as chancellor of the Vermont State Colleges. From 1999 to 2000, he served as interim chancellor. Prior to that, he served as president of Vermont Technical College.

Mr. Clark served as member of the Board of Directors of Central Vermont Public Service and as chair of the Board of Vermont Electric Power Company, Inc. and Vermont Electric Transmission Company, Central Vermont affiliates from 1997 to 2012. He was chair of the Board's Audit Committee and a member of both the Executive and Corporate Governance Committees. Additionally, Mr. Clark served on the Board of TD Banknorth Group, Inc. from 2003 to 2009. He also served as a director of the Richard E. and Deborah L. Tarrant Foundation (a charitable giving foundation).

Mr. Clark earned a bachelor's in Occupational Education from Southern Illinois University, a master's in Occupational Education from Central Washington State College, and a doctorate in Administration and Supervision from Lehigh University.
