Informal Comment Period Now Open through January 20, 2015

An informal comment period for the Project 2014-01 Standards Applicability for Dispersed Generation Resources White Paper is now open through 8 p.m. Eastern on Tuesday, January 20, 2015.

The white paper is intended to provide technical rationale and justification to support identification of standards that will require modifications to applicability for the unique characteristics of dispersed power producing resources as identified under Inclusion I4 of the BES definition that became effective on July 1, 2014. The drafting team will review stakeholder comments and develop modifications for those standards for which modified applicability for dispersed generation resources is justified and supports reliability. In cases where applicability changes are developed for standards that are being modified in another standard development projects, the applicability changes will be coordinated with the drafting team making the technical changes, but will be balloted separately and filed for regulatory approval in a separate petition.
