Additional Ballot and Non-Binding Poll Results

Now Available

An additional ballot for **TOP-001-3 – Transmission Operations** and a non-binding poll of the associated Violation Risk Factors and Violation Severity Levels concluded at **8 p.m. Eastern, Monday, November 10, 2014**.

The standard achieved a quorum but did not receive sufficient affirmative votes for approval. Voting statistics are listed below, and the <u>Ballot Results</u> page provides a link to the detailed results for the ballot.
