The progress status of the 4 sub groups was reviewed. The groups reported good progress for the major issues as identified in San Diego which were:

- 1) R5, R6, R7, R8. (consolidation)
 - applicability
 - force majeure
 - double jeopardy
- 2) Clearances in 1.6
 - Def of Act. ROW
 - Def of V.I.
 - ANSI 300 issue (important)

The consolidation of the former requirements R5 through R8 is done. This consolidation resolved the double jeopardy issue. The issue of GO applicability is pending clearer direction from NERC staff, however Jeff Hackman and sub team members have modified the draft standard in accordance with comments from stakeholders in other parts of the applicability section. The revision of the force majeure language was discussed during a previous web conference however a quorum was not established at the time. Therefore this issue will be formally acted on during the next web conference on January 11, 2010.

The SDT reviewed the definitions of Active Transmission Line ROW and Vegetation Inspections. The preliminary consensus on the Active Transmission Line ROW definition is to leave it as-written and to add additional clarifying text in the white paper to address concerns of NIPSCO and other commenters.
