Additional Ballot and Non-Binding Poll Results

Now Available

An additional ballot for MOD-031-1 and non-binding poll of the associated Violation Risk Factors and Violation Severity Levels concluded at 8 p.m. Eastern on Friday, November 22, 2013.

This standard achieved a quorum but did not receive sufficient affirmative votes for approval. Voting statistics are listed below, and the <u>Ballot Results</u> page provides a link to the detailed results for the ballot.
