- 1. Chairman Charles Rogers opened the meeting at 8 a.m. with introductions.
- 2. Facilitator Richard Schneider took attendance and announced a quorum was present. The NERC Antitrust Compliance Guidelines were reviewed.
- 3. Chairman Rogers reviewed the agenda
- 4. Maureen Long, NERC Standards Process Manager (acting), gave a presentation and held a discussion of the NERC Standard Process and Timeline for development of Standard.
