Project 2007-06.2 Phase 2 of System Protection Coordination TOP-009-1

Initial Ballot and Non-binding Poll Results

Now Available

A formal comment period and initial ballot for TOP-009-1 — Knowledge of Composite Protection Systems and Remedial Action Schemes and Their Effects as well as a non-binding poll of the associated Violation Risk Factors and Violation Severity Levels concluded at 8 p.m. Eastern, Friday, September 11, 2015.

The initial ballot did not receive sufficient affirmative votes for approval. Voting statistics are listed below, and the <u>Ballot Results</u> page provides detailed results for the ballot and non-binding poll.
