NEW CIP-012-1 Reliability Standard Audit Worksheet Posted

A Reliability Standard Audit Worksheet (RSAW) for CIP-012-1 has been posted. CIP-012-1 has an effective date of July 1, 2022 and applies to Real-time Assessment and Real-time monitoring data transmitted between Control Centers.

A RSAW is a guide provided by the ERO Enterprise that describes types of evidence, registered entities may use to demonstrate compliance with a Reliability Standard. RSAWs also include information regarding how the ERO Enterprise may assess that evidence. RSAWs do not require specific evidence to be provided, and they are not

BOARD OF TRUSTEES AND FERC ACTION

NEW NERC Focuses on Resources, Agility to Address Emerging Risks; Previews Summer Assessment, State of Reliability NERC Focuses on Resources, Agility to Address Emerging Risks; Previews Summer Assessment, State of Reliability

Cold weather standards, emerging risks, the summer reliability outlook and a review of 2021 reliability performance were topics of focus at NERC's quarterly Board of Trustees meeting. The meeting was changed to an all-virtual format out of an abundance of caution to safeguard the health of participants after a member of the NERC team tested positive for COVID-19 earlier in the week.

Board Chair Ken DeFontes welcomed virtual attendees, apologizing for any inconvenience caused by the change of meeting format.

"There is much value in us being together in person, but even as the pandemic enters a new phase we must be prepared to respond responsibly to unexpected circumstances," DeFontes said. "The plan is to hold the August MRC/Board meetings in person in Vancouver, Canada, as scheduled, but we are exploring different options in how that may occur." See the full announcement here.

NEW FERC Open Meeting Agenda Posted

FERC released the <u>sunshine agenda notice</u> for its upcoming <u>May 19, 2022 open meeting</u>. There are two items of interest to NERC under its responsibilities from Section 215 of the Federal Power Act:

- E-1 RM20-16-001 Managing Transmission Line Ratings: This item relates to a notice of proposed rulemaking (NOPR), and NERC has previously submitted comments in this proceeding.
- E-16 RR21-10-000 North American Electric Reliability Corporation: This item pertains to a petition from NERC for approval of revisions to its ROP regarding the CMEP.
