for the development of EMT modeling requirements, model 148 quality checks,			
and verification practices specifically for EMT models used to represent BPS-			
connected inverter-based 149 resources in reliability studies conducted by TPs			
and PCs. The guidance presented here is intended specifically to help 150 ensure			
that EMT models provided by GOs are representative of the expected behavior of			
the actual or planned facility to the greatest extent possible. This guideline also			
provides insights on screening considerations to determine when 152 EMT			
studies are needed, when and how to assess ride-through performance, and			
resourcing to prepare for increased 153 workload. This guideline focuses			
specifically on plant models (i.e., a combination of system components and unit-			
154 level models provided by inverter and plant-level controller manufacturers to			
represent the expected behavior of 155 equipment to be (or currently) installed			
in the field).

GENERAL COMPLIANCE AND ENFORCEMENT NEWS

Cold Weather Preparedness Small Group Advisory Sessions Announced

In March 2023 (exact date and time TBD), NERC will host small group advisory sessions (SGAS) with registered entities and the Regional Entities to assess the implementation of the Cold Weather Preparedness Standards:

- EOP-011-2 (Emergency Preparedness and Operations); **R7 & R8 only**
- IRO-010-4 (Reliability Coordinator Data Specification and Collection); R1.3 only
- TOP-003-5 (Transmission Operator Data Specification and Collection); R1.3 only

The event will consist of two parts:

- General Session Live Webinar: A general interest session will be held to discuss the cold weather preparedness standards and possible compliance concerns. This workshop is open to industry, and the webinar announcement will be sent prior to the event.
- SGAS One-on-One Sessions: Closed, one-on-one discussions between a registered entity's subject matter experts (SMEs) and ERO Enterprise staff about issues pertinent to that entity's implementation of the cold weather preparedness standard(s). The registered

entity should provide the ERO Enterprise their questions prior to the scheduled one-on-one session. **NERC will schedule the one-on-one** sessions after registration is received and is coordinated with Regional Entity staff.

- NERC will accept SGAS one-on-one registrations on a first-come, first-serve basis; so if the number of requests exceeds the time allotted, NERC will coordinate alternative arrangements.
 - There is no limit to the number of SMEs who can participate in SGAS sessions.
 - NERC will notify those who request a SGAS of their appointment time so the registered entity can make staff arrangements accordingly.

NEW FERC Open Meeting Agenda

FERC released the Sunshine Act open meeting <u>agenda</u> for its upcoming January 19, 2023 meeting. There is one item of interest for NERC related to its responsibilities under Section 215 of the Federal Power Act:

• E-1 – RM22-3-000 – Internal Network Security Monitoring for High- and Medium-Impact Bulk Electric System (BES) Cyber Systems

This docket concerns the Notice of Proposed Rulemaking issued in January 2022 proposing to direct NERC to revise the CIP Reliability Standards to require internal network security monitoring for medium- and high-impact BES Cyber Systems. NERC and the Regional Entities submitted joint comments in the docket on March 28, 2022.
