NEW Release of Three New Reliability Standard Audit Worksheets for Cold Weather Standards

Three new Reliability Standard Audit Worksheets (RSAWs) have been posted to the <u>RSAW page</u> under the heading "Current RSAWs for Use" for <u>EOP-011-2</u>, <u>IRO-010-4</u>, and <u>TOP-003-5</u>. The effective date of these standards is April 1, 2023. These standards seek to enhance the reliability of the Bulk Electric System during cold weather events by ensuring Generator Owners, Generator Operators, Reliability Coordinators, and Balancing Authorities prepare for extreme cold weather conditions.

BOARD OF TRUSTEES AND FERC ACTION

NEW Board Focuses on Enhanced Stakeholder Engagement, Bids Farewell to Roy Thilly; Launches Technical Session

Enhanced stakeholder engagement and meaningful technical discussions were key features of the first Board of Trustees meeting of 2023. Attendees also bid farewell to a long-time Board member and welcomed a new trustee. Specific actions included the adoption of several standards, a year-end review of 2022 work plan priorities, and an update on standards process improvement activities. <u>Full Announcement</u>

NEW NERC Filings

On February 15, 2023, NERC submitted to FERC a <u>request</u> for approval of the Inverter-Based Resources Work Plan and request for expedited review.

On February 14, 2023, NERC filed an <u>unaudited report</u> of NERC's budget-to-actual variance information for the fourth quarter of 2022. NERC submits this quarterly compliance filing in accordance with FERC's January 16, 2013 Order, which approved a Settlement Agreement between the FERC Office of Enforcement and NERC, related to findings and recommendations arising out of its 2012 performance audit.
