## Survey to Assess the Effectiveness of Severe Winter Weather Preparation Materials

NERC has provided the industry with reports, guidelines and training materials to promote entity cold weather preparedness to ensure reliability of the bulk power system. These products, developed as a result of event analysis and industry collaboration, are intended to emphasize reliability above and beyond mandatory Reliability Standards.

To continuously improve information provided for industry use, NERC and the Event Analysis Subcommittee invites NERC Members and Industry Stakeholders to participate in an ERO wide survey designed to assess the effectiveness of the recommendations and lessons learned from the Southwest Cold Weather event of February 2011, published Reliability Guidelines, cold weather training module, and other materials provided to the industry on the NERC website for cold weather preparedness. The results of the survey will help NERC continuously improve the information provided for preparation of the upcoming winter weather forecasts and entity cold weather preparedness.
